WG scientific meeting; main program

 - Screening for hypertension in adolescents (D. Drozdz,)
 - Out of office BP measurements: when and how (G. Hamdani)
 - Diagnostic evaluation of hypertensive adolescent (T. Seeman)
 - Pharmacological treatment for adolescent hypertension (E. Wuhl)
- There was only one oral session approved among proposals by members of the scientific committee: Oral session 3. Children and Adolescents. Chairs: D. Drozdz, E. Wuhl. Presentation of 6 orals (4/6 on women and pregnancy) and a mini lecture (Task and challenges in the transitioning of adolescents into adult care. Presenter: S. Stabouli)

Short history of WG

The Working Group on Blood Pressure in Children and Adolescents was founded in 2009 by Empar Lurbe, who was the Chair of WG. In 2022 there was a rotation of the WG board, and the current Chair is Stella Stabouli, the Vice Chair is Dorota Drozdz and the Secretary is Dennis Pall.

Under the leadership of Empar Lurbe for 14 years the WG developed the European guidelines on behalf of ESH for the Management of High Blood Pressure in Children and Adolescents in 2009. In 2016 the WG updated the 2009 guidelines as, over the 7 years elapsed from their publication, a large body of new knowledge had been acquired, making, modifications and expansion of the previous recommendations necessary. The Guidelines were translated and published in different languages and countries in Europe and South



America. They have been published in the most important journals in the field of pediatrics and primary care.

In the ESH 2023 guidelines for the management of arterial hypertension the WG contributed to a section on the management of high BP in Children and Adolescents updating and/or reconfirming previous recommendations and for the 1st time the management of high BP in children and adolescents was combined with adult recommendations.

Areas requiring urgent increase in knowledge have been identified and scientific projects

have been developed and some of them submitted to the European Union for financial support. Among others those related to obtain robust reference values for office, home and ambulatory BP based on a European pediatric population; to collect information about early organ damage so as to refine risk stratification and use the information to set intermediate objectives during treatment; to conduct large, long-term randomized therapeutic trials using onset of organ damage and to obtain information about when to initiate anti-hypertensive drug treatment and to decide which BP goals to achieve.

The WG has been organizing specific sessions at the ESH annual meetings devoted to cover the most important issues in this field, receiving more and more abstract submissions from healthcare professionals every year. Members of the Working Group also participate in the annually organized summer schools.

The Working group was involved in the organization of the 1st International Congress in Hypertension in Children and adolescents endorsed by the ESH, held in Valencia in February 2018 and the 2nd one in Warsaw in May 2019 and the upcoming 3rd one in 2025.

A Core Team amongst the members of the WG identified scientific projects that needed urgent increase in knowledge and developed proposal submitted to the European Union for financial support resulting in the first European Network for Hypertension in Children and Adolescents, the HyperChildNET COST ACTION which provided important progress in the field. Empar Lurbe was the Chair of the Action and Elke Wühl was the Vice-Chair. Members of the WG, including Stella Stabouli, Mietek Litwin, Dorota Drozdz and Serap Erdine were in the Core Group of the action.
